


Did you know not all Red Foxes are red? Some are brown, black or even silver!

color Me!


The Great Horned Owl has no horns! It's named for the tufts of feathers that sit on top of its head, called plumicorns.

color Me!


Raccoons have very nimble fingers on their front feet that make it easy for them to untie knots, turn doorknobs and even open jars!
